### **Reablement Outturn 15/16:**

The board discussed the impressive performance of the Reablement Service over the last year, presented by Denise Cross, WCC Service Manager for Integrated Care. The board acknowledged the new functions that Reablement now offers, such as the 'Bridging Service', when long term home care provision is not immediately available. There was recognition for the recent CQC inspection which rated both the North and the South Reablement Service areas as 'Good' in all the five themed areas they inspected and 'Good' overall.

### Spotlight on:

#### **Fit for Frailty Programme:**

Sue Philips, SWCCG Head of Transformation, presented an evaluation of the journey so far and strong indications that the developments in South Warwickshire, including this work, are having a positive impact on A&E / Unplanned Admissions activity. The work now continues with a 'Fit for Frailty' model that incorporates four key components 'prevention and early intervention', 'active case management', 'supporting those with severe frailty' and 'foundation projects'. Learning from the work to date, such as the need to build in collaboration and evaluation at an early stage, as been responded to, as the new elements are progressed.

#### **HomeFirst pending launch:**

Denise Cross and Anne Coyle, Managing Director, SWFT Out of Hospital Care Collaborative, presented the exciting news of the pending launch of the new Warwickshire HomeFirst Services, resulting from a planned integration between WCC Reablement Service and SWFT Intermediate Care and Crisis and Emergency Response Team (CERT) Services. Pending final agreement from WCC Cabinet, huge amounts of work are progressing to successfully deliver this integrated service, which will improve responsiveness, reduce duplication and improve the experiences and outcomes for Warwickshire citizens.
